2025 Constitution Amendments – Proposed

The following proposed changes will be voted on at a Special General Meeting to be held on Wednesday 25th February, 2026.

Section 3:

Terms Used (page 8)

Amend to:

Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 Association means an Incorporated Association aligned with Netball WA definitions.

Remove following section:

Voting member means the:

- (a) Regions up to and including 31 December 2018; and
- (b) Tier 1 Association on or after 1 January 2019.

Reason: these are no longer relevant!

Section 17

Register of members – add the following:

When using information in the Register of Members is prohibited A Member must not use or disclose any information in the Register of Members: (a) to gain access to information that a Member has deliberately denied them; (b) to contact or send material to Netball WA or a Member for the purpose of advertising political, religious, charitable or commercial purposes, unless the use of the information is approved by the chief executive officer; or (c) for any other purpose, unless the purpose: (i) is directly connected with the affairs of Netball WA; or (ii) is related to the administration of the Act.

Section 18 – Part 2

Compliance of Affiliated Clubs – amend to the following:

FROM

Part a) – x) elect or appoint 2 adult delegates

TO

Part a) – x) elect or appoint a minimum of 1 adult delegate

Part b) – ii) remove this (not be a member of the Association's committee)

Otherwise Committee members cannot also be club delegates!

Section 24 – Treasurer

Combine parts 6 and 7

They simply separate the different Tier 1, 2 and 3 – but are exactly the same sentences!

Section 26 – Nomination of committee members – part 2

Amend from current 28 days to 14 days – notice before AGM.

Section 29 – Term of Office

Amend from:

A committee member may be re-elected, provided that they must hold office for no more than 6 consecutive years

TO

A committee member may be re-elected, provided they hold the same office for no more than 6 consecutive years

This will enable executive positions to be changed, so people can continue on the committee without a minimum 12 month hiatus from ANY position.

Section 72 – By-Laws

Amend part 1 from;

60 days prior

TO

30 days prior

More flexibility to commence changes without long delays/lead times.

Duties of Secretary

Additional requirement to lodge the annual information statement to Consumer Protection.

This is a new requirement for all associations.
